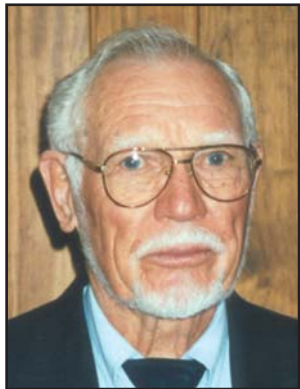

Vote "Yes" On Amendment No. 7!

During the 2006 Legislative Session, **Florida PBA's Senior Lobbyist Ed Hoffman**, a WWII and Korean War Marine Corps Veteran, successfully and single-handedly lobbied to add Amendment No. 7 to Florida's 2006 Statewide General Election ballot. The amendment provides some property tax relief to veterans over the age of 65 who meet certain requirements of military service. Mr. Hoffman, known for his passion and

persistence at the Capitol, felt strongly about providing some financial relief to these veterans while also paying tribute to America's "Greatest Generation." Now we are asking you to

help Mr. Hoffman finish the job by supporting Amendment No. 7 on November 7th.

If the amendment passes, it will provide the veteran with an ad valorem tax discount on homestead property equivalent to the percentage of the veteran's permanent service-connected disability. The veteran must meet all four of the following criteria:

- 1) the veteran must have been a Florida resident at the time of entering military service,
- 2) the veteran must be age 65 or older,
- 3) the veteran must have received a combat related disability, and
- 4) the veteran must have been honorable discharged from military service.

Supporting this amendment is the least we can do for our veterans, many of whom are on a fixed incomes.

The Florida PBA asks you vote "YES" on Amendment No. 7. Thank you! ●
